2. All rabbits entered in the youth show must be handled by youth. Youth entries exhibited by adults will be transferred to the open show.
3. Entry Fee: \$4.50 per show. Open/Youth Classes, Meat Pens and Fur

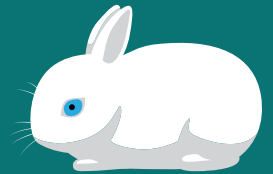

4. Please remember the same rabbit cannot be entered in both the Youth and Open shows. Youth and Open entries must enter separately.
5. All rabbits / covies must be permanently and legibly ear marked or they will be disqualified from competition.
6. Sunflower RBA will not be responsible for any injury or accident occurring during the show according to Kansas Law:

7. Any adults not properly supervising unruly or destructive children will be asked to leave the property immediately. Entry fees will not be refunded.
8. Show officials reserve the right to substitute or add a judge if necessary.
9. Equipment and Sales Displays must have permission from the Show Superintendent to setup.
10. Any animal showing signs of illness or disease will be removed from the showroom.
11. Only rabbits and covies entered in the show are allowed in the building. Sale animals not entered in the show must be kept outside the building.
12. Weather permitting, grooming of wool breeds should be done outside of the building.
13. No Dogs (except those allowed by law, with proof), Cats, Scooters, Roller Skates, Skate Boards or Roller Blades allowed in the building.
14. This is a carrier show, use leak proof carriers, if your carrier creates a mess, you will be expected to clean-up after yourself.
15. No outside chairs allowed in the building.
