

## 2020 Virtual State Fair Rabbit Exhibits

1. All exhibits that are entered into the 4-H Rabbit Division at the State Fair will need to be entered through the FairEntry system through your Local Extension Office and abide by all Local Extension Office deadlines for State Fair Entries.
2. Because 2020 Rabbit Exhibit classes at the Kansas State Fair are most likely different classes than were offered at local county fairs, State Fair 4-H Rabbit entries **do not need** to be displayed, evaluated or qualified on a local level. Youth who had a state fair blue or purple on any county fair 4-H rabbit entry may exhibit in **one** of the classes at the virtual state fair.
3. Youth may enter only **one** class, i.e. 1 exhibit in rabbit division per exhibitor.
4. The Rabbit Judging Contest and Rabbit Showmanship will not be held this year.

### **\*NEW 2020\* CLASS NUMBER 3470 - Rabbit Educational Poster – Listed with Centennial Hall**

1. Posters must be designed in a “portrait” format and readable from a photo or uploaded PDF
2. Choose one of the recommended topics: a) Story of your project and what you have learned; b) Kansas Rabbit Industry; c) Rabbit Disease or d) Miscellaneous including breed, fur, body type... e) What do you learn by participating in Rabbit Showmanship.
3. Copyright laws as explained in the General Rules section for 4-H Exhibitors must be followed.
4. Scoring is as follows:
  1. General Appearance – 15%
  2. Quality of Work – 15%
  3. Creativity – 15%
  4. Ability to Attract & Hold Attention – 15%
  5. Content – 40%

### **\*NEW 2020\* CLASS NUMBER 3471 - Rabbit Educational Report – Listed with Centennial hall**

- 1) Maximum length of report is 3 double spaced pages
- 2) Choose one of the recommended topics: a) Report of your project and what you have learned; b) Kansas Rabbit Industry; c) Rabbit Disease or d) Miscellaneous including breed, fur, body type... e) What do you learn by participating in Rabbit Showmanship.
- 3) Reports should be uploaded in a PDF format.
- 4) Scoring is as follows:
  - a. Introduction– 20%
  - b. Content – 50%
  - c. Appropriate Visuals/Charts– 10%
  - d. Summary – 10%
  - e. References – 10%

**Virtual Rabbit Exhibit – Listed in KS4-H/FFA Small Animals  
for ribbon only, no best of show, no best of breed, no champions. This will consist of 6 photos  
of one of the 4-H member's rabbits.**

Pre junior (under 3 months) classes only available in the following breeds: Argente Braun, Beveren, Blanc de Hotot, Californian, Champagne D'Argent, Checkered Giant, American Chinchilla, Giant Chinchilla, Cinnamon, Creme D'Argent, New Zealand, and Palomino. Juniors (under 6 months). Intermediate (6-8 months) classes only available in the following breeds: American, Giant Angora, Argente Braun, Beveren, Blanc de Hotot, Californian, Champagne D'Argent, Checkered Giant, American Chinchilla, Giant Chinchilla, Cinnamon, Crème D'Argent, Flemish Giant, English Lop, French Lop, New Zealand, Palomino, Satin and Silver Fox. Senior, six months of age or over for breeds other than those listed as having Intermediate classes, eight months of age or over for breeds having Intermediate classes.

Rabbits will be divided into classes by ages and judged according to their breed standard as listed in the ARBA "Standard of Perfection". Only breeds approved by ARBA may be exhibited, no mixed breed rabbits will be allowed.

3400 Senior buck. Eight months of age and over for breeds with Intermediate classes; six months and over for all other breeds.

3401 Senior doe. Eight months of age and over for breeds with Intermediate classes; six months and over for all other breeds.

3402 Intermediate buck. Only breeds listed above with Intermediate classes.

3403 Intermediate doe. Only breeds listed above with Intermediate classes.

3404 Junior buck. Under six months of age.

3405 Junior doe. Under six months of age.

3406 Pre-junior buck. Only breeds listed above with pre-juniors.

3407 Pre-junior doe. Only breeds listed above with pre-juniors.

Within the FairEntry system there are fields for breed and variety.

Youth should have 6 photos within one upload (PDF Document). Cannot hold the head of rabbit in photos. Rabbit should fill the picture frame. Views should include:

1. Photo Right Side of rabbit
2. Photo Left Side of rabbit
3. Photo Front of Rabbit
4. Photo Rear of Rabbit
5. Photo Top of Rabbit
6. Photo Fur/Color – Roll Back or Blow for photo

Please create one PDF file with all required photos. To create your PDF a word processing program or PowerPoint can be used. Please place one photo per page/slide, then either save as or print to PDF.
