Show Rules

1. This show will be judged in accordance with the most current ARBA Standards of Perfection. Entry indicates acceptance of these rules.
2. You must be a 4-H or FFA member to enter and show at this show. 4-Hers are responsible for getting their own rabbits to and from the judging table.
3. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in the left ear.
4. Exhibitors must fill out their own comment cards for entries and turn them in with their entry. ARBA two-part comment cards will be used. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to pick up their comment cards after judging. They will not be mailed.
5. Your comment cards and entry forms must match. If the comment cards don't match the entry form, rabbits may be placed incorrectly or given a "no place". Please inform Show Secretary of any changes made to an entry. If the ear number on the comment card doesn't match the rabbit's tattoo the judge will disqualify the rabbit.
6. Entries are due by 8:30am on the day of the show. Regular entries \$3.50, Meat Pen \$7.00, and Fur/Wool \$2.00. If you want to prepare before the show, generic entry sheets are on the Kansas Rabbit Breeders Association website www.ksrba.com. Day of show entries only, no pre-entry.
7. Fur and wool entries must be shown in a regular breed class. All wool breeds must be groomed outside.
8. There are prizes for Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex (No minimum), Best in Show, Reserve in Show, and 2nd Reserve in Show along with Champion and Reserve Champion in Showmanship and Judging.
9. Rabbits must be in a leak proof carrier. You are responsible for your own messes!
10. No Dogs (except those allowed by law), Cats, Scooters, Roller Skates, Skate Boards or Roller Blades allowed in the building. .
11. Equipment and Sales Displays must have permission from the Show Superintendent to setup.
12. Any animals showing signs of illness or disease will be removed from the showroom. No entries will be accepted from any location within 125 miles which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCV/RHD/VHD in the past 60 days on the entry deadline.
13. Any out of state entries are required to provide a current CVI (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) from a licenses veterinarian in your state and must be issued and valid in less than 30 days from show day. Entry permits are not required in Kansas at this time.
14. Any adults not properly supervising unruly or destructive children will be asked to leave the property immediately. Entry fees will not be refunded.
15. The Hop to It Rabbit Club and Lyon County 4-H Extension and all concerned are not responsible for injury or accidents in the show room or on the fairgrounds with parents responsible for the acts of their own children.
