Show Rules

1. This show will be judged in accordance with the current ARBA Standards of Perfection as of December 1st, 2018. Entry indicates acceptance of these rules.
2. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly tattooed in the left ear.
3. Rabbits must be in a leak proof carrier. You are responsible for your own messes!
4. Fur and wool entries must be shown in a regular breed class.
5. You must be a 4-H or FFA member to enter and show at this show. 4-Hers are responsible for getting their own rabbits to and from the judging table.
6. Exhibitors must fill out their own comment cards for entries and turn them in with their entry.
7. The Hop to It Rabbit Club and Lyon County 4-H Extension and all concerned are not responsible for injury or accidents in the show room or on the fairgrounds with parents responsible for the acts of their own children.
8. Any animals showing signs of illness or disease will be removed from the showroom. The Hop to It Rabbit Club reserves the right to refuse entries from exhibitors placing an entry from all locations within 150 miles which has had a confirmed outbreak of RCV/RHD/VHD within the past 60 days on the entry deadline.
9. Entries are due by 8:30am on the day of the show. Regular entries \$3.00, Meat Pen \$3.00, and Fur/Wool \$1.50. If you want to prepare before the show, generic entry sheets are on the Kansas Rabbit Breeders Association website www.ksrba.com
10. There are prizes for Best of Breed and Best Opposite Sex (No minimum), Best in Show, Reserve in Show, and 2nd Reserve in Show along with Champion and Reserve Champion in Showmanship and Judging.
